# About the Visit

Visitors to the Katsura Imperial Villa, you are required to take a tour guided by our staff. Free access is not permitted. The tour has limited capacity; therefore, it is necessary to apply. **The tour does not include the interiors of the buildings**.

[Time Slots] Tours are available in both English and Japanese.

- 18 years old or older: 1,000 yen per visit
- 12 years old 17 years old: free admission
- Holders of a disability certificate: free admission. One accompanying person of a certificate holder: free admission

# [Notes]

- All visitors are required to show identification (passport or other government-issued document) at the entrance.
- The visitor's path is about 1 km long, with stone bridges without handrails, large steps, and small hills. Please note that you will be walking on unstable ground.

- 1. Mondays (If Monday is a national holiday, the office is open on the holiday and closed on Tuesday)
- 2. New Year holidays (December 28 January 4)
- 3. Any day when events and other operational reasons occur.

## About Application No applications will be accepted once capacity is reached.

- 1. Visitors must be aged 12 years or over. Visitors younger than 12 years (including toddlers and infants) are not permitted to enter.
- 2. A main applicant may include up to three accompanying persons in the application. This is only possible if there are vacancies.
- 3. Applications submitted by proxy, travel agents, or related industries will not be accepted.
- 4. The following information is required at the time of application:
  - For all participants: Name, age, and nationality.
  - For the main applicant: In addition to the above information, contact phone number and email address.
- 5. Each in-person applicant is required to present an ID.

#### Advance Application

- **Online** (Click here to go to the application page)
  - Application acceptance period: 3 months in advance from the first day of that month until 3 days before your preferred date.

For example: If your preferred date is 10 November, you can apply for that date from 05:00 on 1 August until 23:59 on 7 November.

• If the number of applications exceeds the allocated capacity for that day, a lottery will be conducted. The results will be emailed to you within 3 working days.

#### In Person at the Kyoto Office of the Imperial Household Agency

- Application acceptance period: 3 months in advance from the first day of that month until 1 day before your preferred date. However, please note that it may not be possible to issue a permit.
- ID is required.
- Please be sure to check the Contact Section for details of the Kyoto Office.

#### Walk-in Registration: In Person at the Katsura Imperial Villa

Walk in registrations are only available for the Japanese guided tours.

[Capacity] 70 persons per day (10 persons per tour)

[Registration Process]

- Reception starts at 8:40.
- Numbered tickets with specific tour times will be issued on a first come, first served basis. Registration will be closed once the capacity is reached. ID is required to collect the ticket.
- Registration form requires each participant's full name, age, and nationality.
